Our SGEU brothers and sisters at Saskatchewan Cancer Agency and Saskatchewan Crop Insurance have secured strong strike mandates. Crop Insurance started job action on June 3rd by withdrawing overtime and following "work to rule." We continue to monitor the negotiations of the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation and Saskatchewan Health Sciences who are at the table this month. We are also working with SGEU Communications to develop a public awareness radio campaign.
